This year's Eastermarch for Peace and Justice is locus of a special action: **Berlin's World-Wide Longest Banner Against the Death Penalty and for Mumia Abu-Jamal**, Afro-American journalist from Philadelphia, who has had to spend his last 30 years in prison - about 29 of them on death row - unconstitutionally, as courts ruled in 2011.

Supporters around Germany have worked for months to prepare a 660 meter-long-banner with our demands. The purpose: to wrap the US Embassy today.

MUMIA ABU-JAMAL

Arrested in 1981, convicted for the killing of police officer Daniel Faulkner, he has always protested his innocence. On Pennsylvania's death row from May 1983 to December 2011.

With his radio columns and his essays about prison conditions journalist and writer Abu-Jamal has given hitherto invisible prisoners a voice and has become one of the most prominent faces of the struggle against capital punishment worldwide.

His case is a glaring example for racism and arbitrary justice in the United States of America.

In spite of an incredible 29 years on death row the former Black Panther is still alive and kicking. His insights into the conditions in US prisons, the prison industry as well as power and injustice in the United States have been an inspiration for tens of thousands around the world, including the peace movement.

In 2011 his conviction was finally overturned as unconstitutional.

The US's criminal justice system, though, refuses to release Mumia from prison, but rather wants to keep him there until he dies.

This is not acceptable. Mumia Abu-Jamal must be free. Life in prison is no alternative.
